

I am counsel to Paul Konigsberg and the firm of Konigsberg Wolf and write in response to your April 23 article ("Was Madoff 'Victim' and Best Friend an Accomplice?") which suggested that Paul Konigsberg and Konigsberg Wolf were involved in misconduct with Bernard Madoff. Mr. Konigsberg was never involved, at any time, by any means, in the transfer of monies between the New York and London operations of Mr. Madoff and to suggest that he was involved in money laundering or any other improper conduct with Mr. Madoff is false. Nor was Mr. Konigsberg ever paid \$30,000 per month by any Madoff entity or Mr. Madoff personally, as your article reported was purportedly reflected in a general ledger of Madoff accounts.

Although Mr. Konigsberg did acquire a miniscule, .024% interest in MSIL as a result of work he did in 1983 when the London operation was set up, he never received any income or other financial benefit. Mr. Konigsberg was in London on a couple of occasions in the 1980s, but has not been there since 1994. When he was in London after the early 1980s it was purely for non-business purposes. On those occasions he might have stopped by the London office to say hello to people he met when he did the work mentioned above. However, he never gave direction to anyone at MSIL while he was in London, New York or anywhere else. In short, any suggestion that Paul Konigsberg or Konigsberg Wolf have been implicated in Mr. Madoff's activities is false.
